Application & Acceptance Fees

When submitting an application for any course, a non-refundable fee of £25 is payable. Upon acceptance onto the course the following fees apply:

* Acceptance Fee - £50

* All new first-year undergraduate students are required to pay an acceptance fee of £50 upon acceptance, in order to hold their place on the course. These will be offset against the first year's fees. From the date of signing and returning the Acceptance Letter, candidates have a fourteen day 'cooling off' period, during which they may cancel the agreement, and receive a full refund of the acceptance fee. After that fourteen-day period, the acceptance fee is non-refundable.

Payment Schedule

Where a student is not in receipt of Student Finance:

50% of the fee must be paid by 1 September 2023. A further 25% of the fee must be paid by 6 January 2024. The final 25% is to be paid by 14 April 2024.

For further information, contact the college and speak to our finance department. Where we have evidence that a student is in receipt of student finance, the annual fee is divided into three termly instalments in which funds are made available to students. Students are expected to make payments as soon as student funding is received.

Please note, facilities fees are not covered by student tuition loans and any shortfall between student finance and tuition fees must be paid by the student directly. A student can also apply for a maintenance loan through student finance. If you would like to discuss this further, please contact the college.
